**2-Day Scientific Programme 10<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> May 2002**

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to invite you joining 2-day scientific programme from 10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> May 2002. On 10<sup>th</sup> of May, there will be a dinner symposium, which will be held in the lecture theatre, M/F of Hospital Authority Building. This function is organized by The Hong Kong Society for Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (HKSCCP) and was sponsored by the "Digene Corporation". We have invited 2 speakers including Dr. Mahmood Shafi, Consultant Gynaecological Surgeon and Oncologist from Birmingham Women's Hospital of UK and Dr. Annie Cheung, Associate Professor from Department of Pathology of Queen Mary Hospital. Dr. Shafi will talk on the 'New advances in the management of abnormal cervical cytology' and Dr. Cheung will talk on the 'Recent advances in gynaecological cytopathology'.

On 11<sup>th</sup> of May, we will have a whole-day colposcopy workshop. This workshop is jointly organized by The HKSCCP, The Hong Kong College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists and The Department of O&G, Queen Mary Hospital. In the morning session, there will be lectures on colposcopy and cervical pathology. In the afternoon, there will be a hands-on session. There will be a live demonstration on colposcopic examination and treatment for abnormal cervical pathology. Delegates will also have the chance to practice electro-surgical excision procedures on models.

At the same time, The HKSCCP and The Hong Kong College of Pathologists will coorganize a slide seminar on cervical and vaginal pathology. It will be held on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2002 2:00 pm at 1/F, Lecture Theatre of University Pathology Building, Queen Mary Hospital, Hong Kong. There will be a total of 12 interesting cases on cervical and vaginal pathology, contributed by different hospitals in Hong Kong. The selected cases cover diagnostic pitfalls in histopathology and cytology, recently described findings in gynaecological pathology and their clinical relevance.

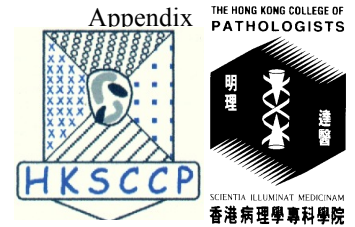

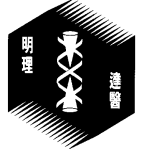
